Website Sections

1. Home Page

- Welcome: Quick intro about helping new students to Eindhoven.
- Quick Links: Buttons that go directly to important topics like "Where to Live," "How to Get Around," and "Dutch Culture."
- Seasonal Advice: Tips based on the time of year, like winter weather or holiday events.

2. About Us Page

- Mission: Short explanation that this blog is a friendly guide for new students or travelers.
- Author Info: A brief introduction about you and why you're interested in helping students.
- Contact Details: An email or contact form for people to reach out with questions.

3. Main Guide Section

- Getting Settled
 - Visa Info: Basics of what you need for visas or residency.
 - Finding Housing: Tips for where to look for apartments, typical rent costs, and the best neighborhoods.
 - Setting Up Utilities: Quick guide to setting up water, electricity, and Wi-Fi.
- Day-to-Day Life
 - Transportation: Overview of the local bus and train system, and how to get a transport card (OV-chip cards).
 - Biking: How to rent, buy, or use a bike in Eindhoven.
 - Banking: Steps to open a bank account and information about payment methods.
 - Healthcare: Guide to getting health insurance and finding a doctor.
- Culture & Social Tips
 - Dutch Etiquette: Basics on Dutch manners, personal space, and direct communication.
 - Common Dutch Phrases: A few helpful words for everyday use.

- Local Events: Information on big events like King's Day, Glow Eindhoven, and Dutch Design Week.
